Dryer Vent Heat Keeper

TOOLS REQUIRED





Utility Knife

HARDWARE REQUIRED (NOT INCLUDED)



Adjustable clamp

Installation

CUTTING THE EXISTING DUCT

 Cut the existing duct attached to the dryer about 10 in. above the top control panel of the dryer.



2 ATTACHING THE DUCT FROM THE DRYER TO THE HEAT KEEPER

 Slide the free end of the duct coming from the dryer over the bottom collar of the Heat Keeper.
Secure it with an adjustable clamp.



3 ATTACHING THE DUCT FROM THE PIPE TO THE HEAT KEEPER

 Slide the free end of the remaining duct leading outside over the top collar of the Heat Keeper. Secure it with an adjustable clamp.



4. SETTING THE HEAT KEEPER FOR WINTER MODE

 Set the Heat Keeper (pull and turn damper) in the up position during the winter season to add heat and humidity into the home through the lint filter.



5 SETTING THE HEAT KEEPER FOR SUMMER MODE

 Set the Heat Keeper (pull and turn damper) in the down position during the summer season to redirect heat and humidity from the dryer, directly outdoors.



Note

For maximum efficiency, clean the lint filter cap before each use.
